Instructions:

The family will pursue all funding options through local and state resources first. If no funding is available, CMN Hospitals can be considered for funding:



- 1. A child must have a medical diagnosis, injury or disability to be considered for funding.
- 2. Applications will be accepted from families living in CMN Hospitals Service Area:
 - <u>Wisconsin:</u> Buffalo, Chippewa, Crawford, Dunn, Eau Claire, Grant, Jackson, Juneau, La Crosse, Monroe, Pepin, Richland, Rusk, Trempealeau, and Vernon Counties.
 - Minnesota: Fillmore, Houston, Wabasha, and Winona Counties.
 - <u>Iowa:</u> Allamakee, Clayton, Fayette, Howard, and Winneshiek Counties.
- 3. The grant will directly benefit the child or the family's ability to care for the child.
- 4. Funding requests are accepted for the following:
 - Expectant Mothers (currently pregnant before submission of a grant) with a high risk pregnancy. (Diagnosed by a physician)
 - Children 0-18 years.
 - Children with disabilities that remain in the public school system from 18-21 will be considered if the applicant is still under a pediatric provider's care.
- 5. Each grant application must accompany a letter of recommendation from a medical clinician and needs to be scanned in with this application.
- 6. A social worker from Children's Miracle Network Hospitals will reach out to you if additional information is needed.
- 7. Once the grant is approved, you will receive a letter from the CMN Hospitals office for next steps. Please note that it can take up to 3 weeks to process a grant once all the information is submitted. Grant payments will be made <u>directly to the vendor</u> in all possible cases. Families are responsible for placing their orders with the vendor, getting the information that is needed for CMN Hospitals to send the check directly.
