

## Instructions:

The family will pursue all funding options through local and state resources first. If no funding is available, CMN Hospitals can be considered for funding:



1. A child must have a medical diagnosis, injury or disability to be considered for funding.
2. Applications will be accepted from families living in CMN Hospitals Service Area:
  - Wisconsin: Buffalo, Chippewa, Crawford, Dunn, Eau Claire, Grant, Jackson, Juneau, La Crosse, Monroe, Pepin, Richland, Rusk, Trempealeau, and Vernon Counties.
  - Minnesota: Fillmore, Houston, Wabasha, and Winona Counties.
  - Iowa: Allamakee, Clayton, Fayette, Howard, and Winneshiek Counties.
3. The grant will directly benefit the child or the family's ability to care for the child.
4. Funding requests are accepted for the following:
  - Expectant Mothers (currently pregnant before submission of a grant) with a high risk pregnancy. (Diagnosed by a physician)
  - Children 0-18 years.
    - Children with disabilities that remain in the public school system from 18- 21 will be considered if the applicant is still under a pediatric provider's care.
5. Each grant application must accompany a letter of recommendation from a medical clinician and needs to be scanned in with this application.
6. A social worker from Children's Miracle Network Hospitals will reach out to you if additional information is needed.
7. Once the grant is approved, you will receive a letter from the CMN Hospitals office for next steps. Please note that it can take up to 3 weeks to process a grant once all the information is submitted. Grant payments will be made directly to the vendor in all possible cases. Families are responsible for placing their orders with the vendor, getting the information that is needed for CMN Hospitals to send the check directly.
